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Ontario Telemedicine Network

The Ontario Telemedicine Network (OTN) Clinic is conveniently located in downtown Peterborough with appointments available in over 40 different specialties. OTN is a clinical medical appointment with a physician or specialist using two-way videoconferencing and specialized equipment.

This is a free service to Ontario residents.

Just like a regular doctor's appointment.

This service can be used for:

- patient referrals
- initial, pre and/or follow-up appointments
- specialist appointments for children, teens and adults

For Patients

Prior to your appointment, the physician or specialist is sent any important information they will need regarding your medical history. You may also be asked to bring medications and other documentation with you.

You will be connected with the physician/specialist using secure two-way videoconferencing equipment. You will be able to see, hear and speak with the doctor directly. The appointment is private, but a registered nurse may help with some aspects of the appointment such as; taking blood pressure or using a stethoscope for heart and breath sounds.
