Former Great Big Sea member Sean McCann is reaching out to a whole new audience, by speaking out and singing about mental health and addiction. Sean has been very outspoken about his struggle with addiction as his way to deal with the trauma of childhood sexual abuse by his parish priest, while growing up in St. John's Nfld. This same priest also introduced him to alcohol. As told to CTV's Canada AM, McCann said: "I lived with a secret for 32 years and it almost killed me. I know firsthand the value of talking about your problems and facing them, and not keeping them inside." McCann released a single in 2015 "You Know I love You", which he said is a reminder that no one is alone and that it's ok to talk about difficult issues." <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=cGLxEktfbbY</u> Sean McCann is also one of Bell Let's Talk ambassadors.

Kerri Davies of CMHA HKPR and Chad Hogan of Market Hall have been planning this event since June of this year. "When Chad approached us to see if we would like to partner in Sean's Road to Recovery Tour, we immediately said yes. Having a well known musician like Mr. McCann's prepared to talk about his own struggles with mental health and addiction helps to bring the conversation about mental illness out in the open. Making the announcement of this event on November 1st, the beginning of "Movember", a month focusing on Men's health worked very well. Including it at the Peterborough Chamber of Commerce PBX event was also important, as our local Chamber has also been very supportive of supporting mental health initiatives, particularly as they relate to the workplace." Chad Hogan, General Manager of Market Hall states "Market Hall is always looking for ways to support our community, so bringing such an important Canadian musician to Peterborough and advancing the conversation of mental health, was a great fit."
