What is CMHA?

The Canadian Mental Health Association (CMHA) is a nationwide nonprofit that provides leadership and support on mental health issues through community-based mental health care. CMHA plays a crucial role in promoting mental health and well-being across Canada, offering a wide range of services and programs tailored to meet the unique needs of individuals and communities. These services include crisis intervention, suicide prevention, substance use treatment, housing support, employment services, and peer support groups, among others. The CMHA operates at a local level through branches, ensuring that mental health resources and support are accessible to everyone, regardless of their location or financial situation.

By providing services within the community, the CMHA can reach those who might otherwise go unnoticed or underserved by traditional healthcare systems. This approach fosters a sense of knowledge, hope and belonging, reducing stigma associated with mental illness and encouraging open conversations about mental health. CMHA empowers individuals and families to take an active role in their recovery journey, leveraging the collective knowledge and strengths of the community to create supportive networks that enhance resilience and well-being.

Our Branch

The Canadian Mental Health Association, Haliburton, Kawartha, Pine Ridge (CMHA HKPR) was formed in April 2013 through the amalgamation of two area branches. The Canadian Mental Health Association Kawartha Lakes (CMHA KL) and Peterborough (CMHA PTBO) branches merged to create this new branch that serves the City of Kawartha Lakes, Haliburton County, Northumberland County, Peterborough County, and the City of Peterborough.

These previous iterations had established strong connections within their communities. The CMHA Victoria County Branch (later renamed Kawartha Lakes) was established in 1989 and had provided mental health support to individuals aged 18 and older in what was then Victoria County. CMHA PTBO was established in 1959 and offered mental health support for anyone aged 16 to 65. Following the amalgamation, CMHA HKPR found common ground supporting anyone 16 and older.

Our Mission

The Canadian Mental Health Haliburton. Association. Kawartha, Pine Ridge (CMHA committed HKPR), is to improving mental health and addiction services in the community. Our mission is to enhance the lives of people in the HKPR community through leadership, collaboration, continual pursuit of the excellence in community-based mental health and addictions services.
